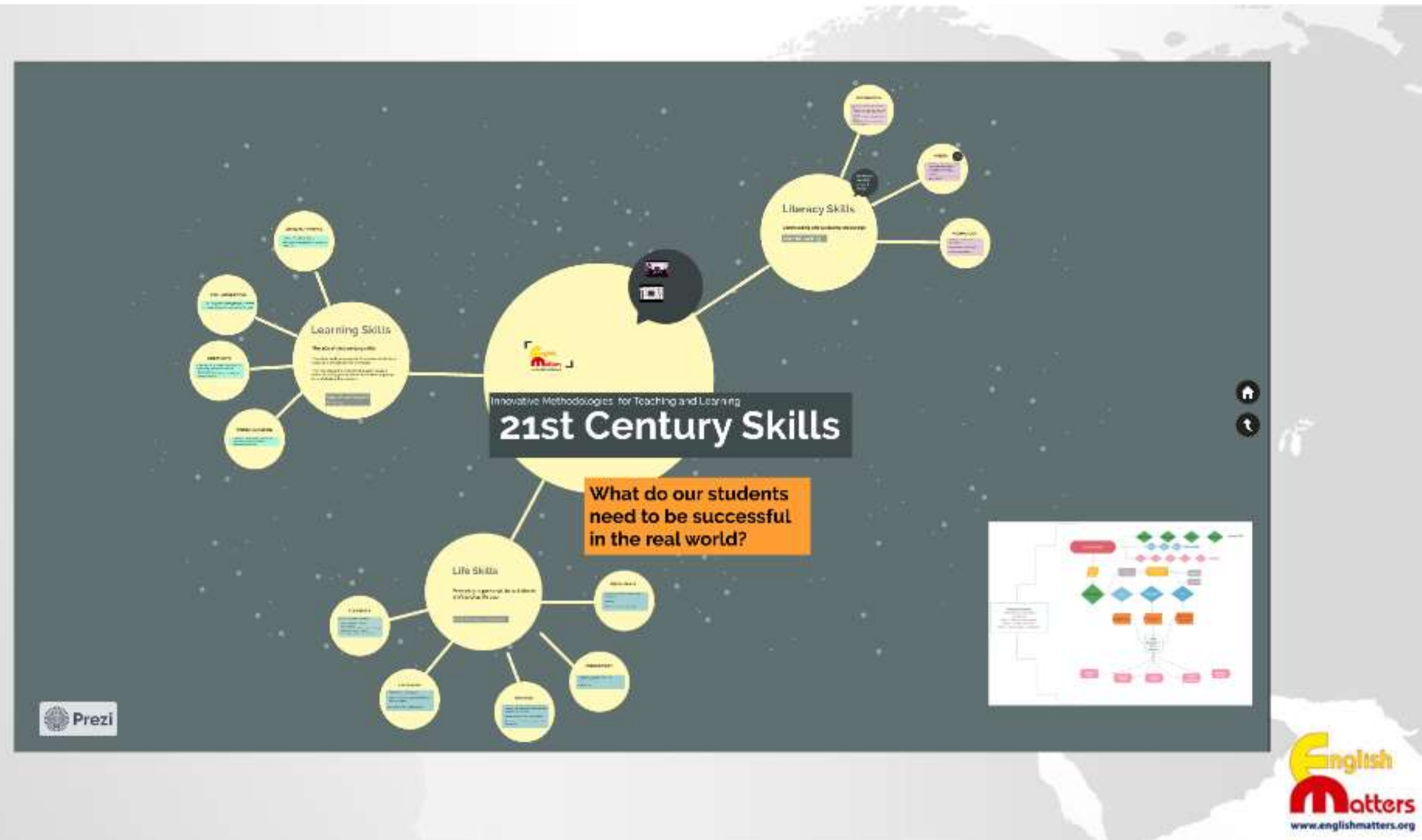

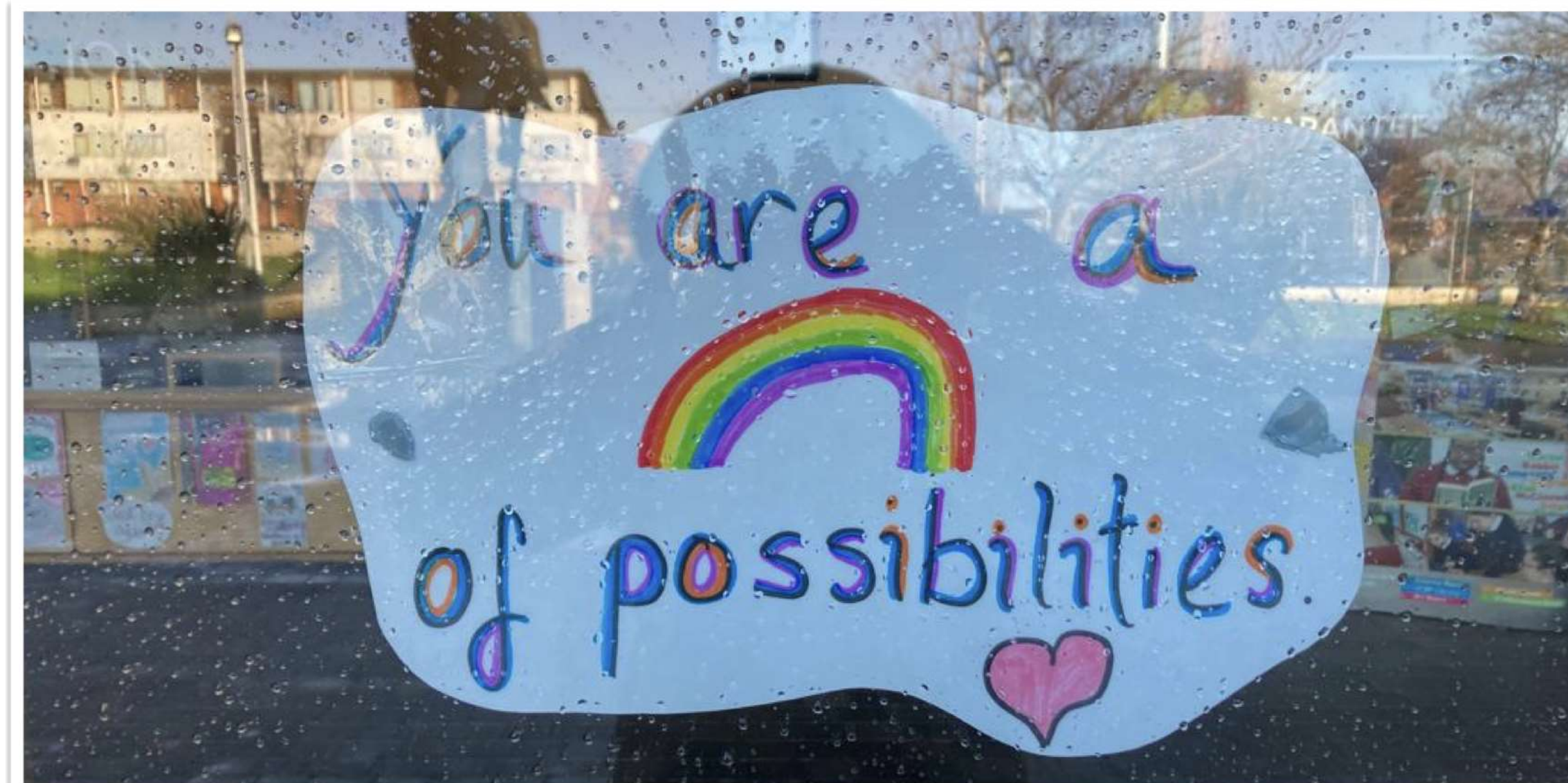
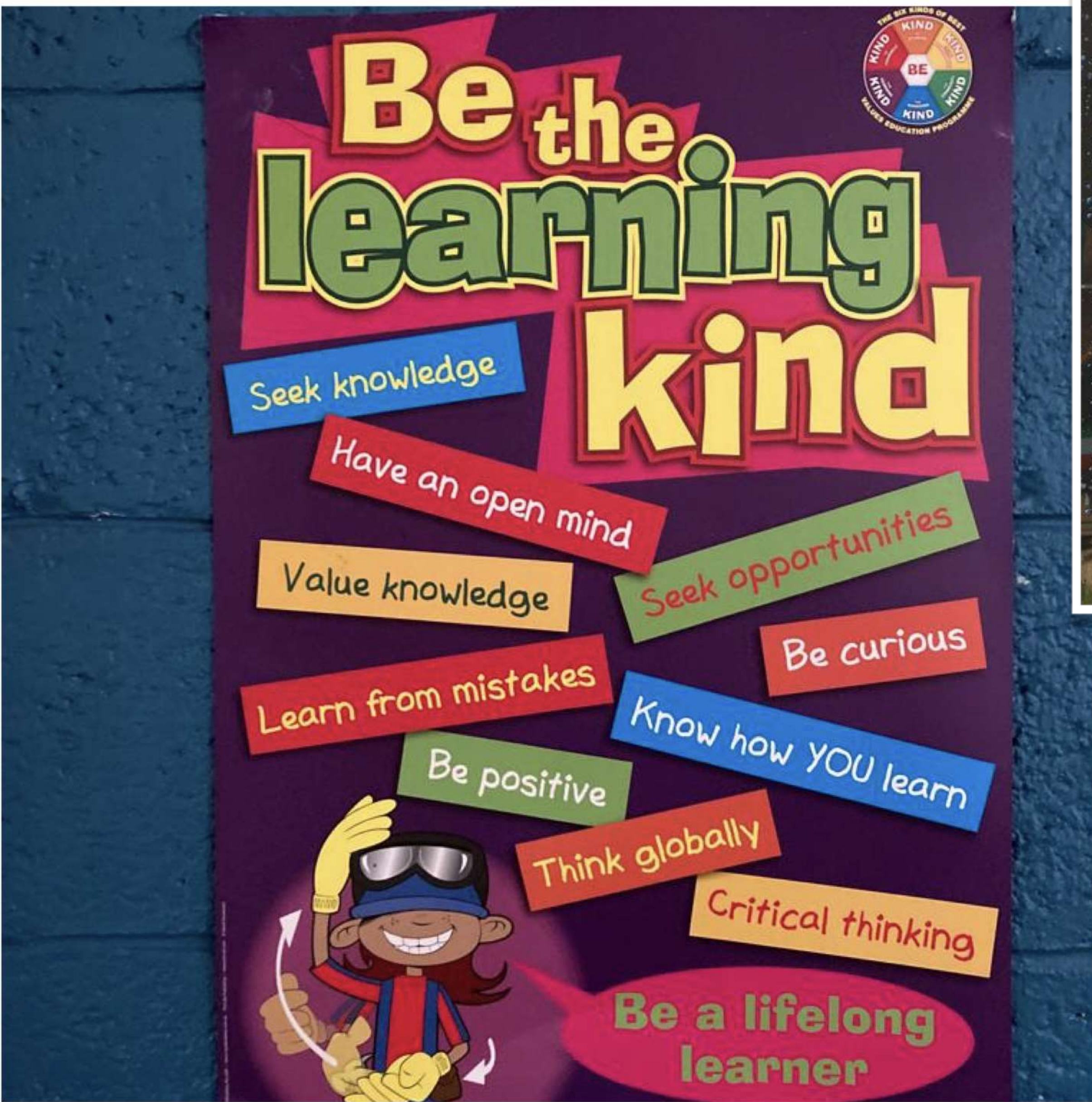

The programme aims to help young people experience success and develop a positive self-image by providing a curriculum and assessment framework suitable to their needs.

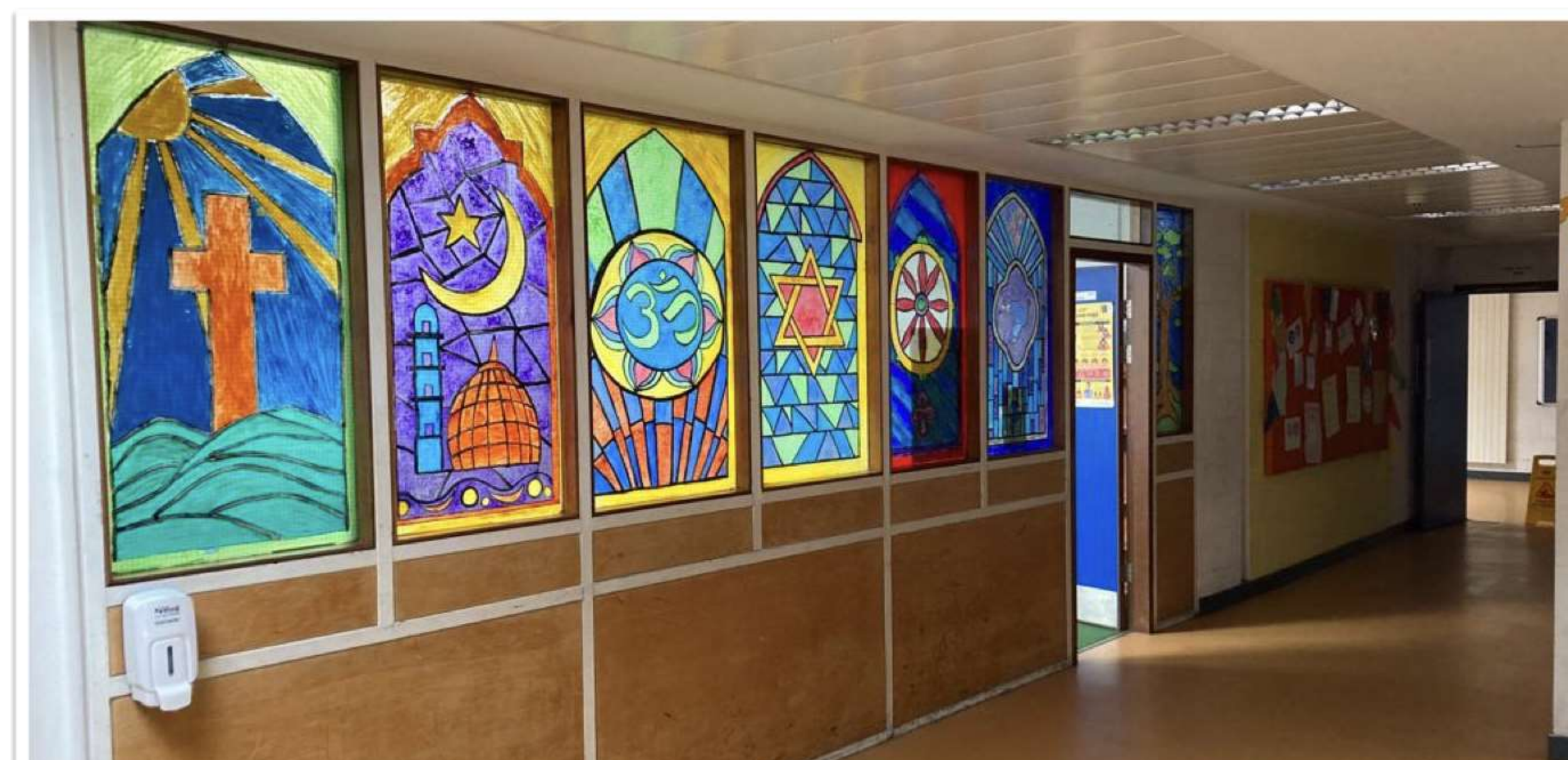
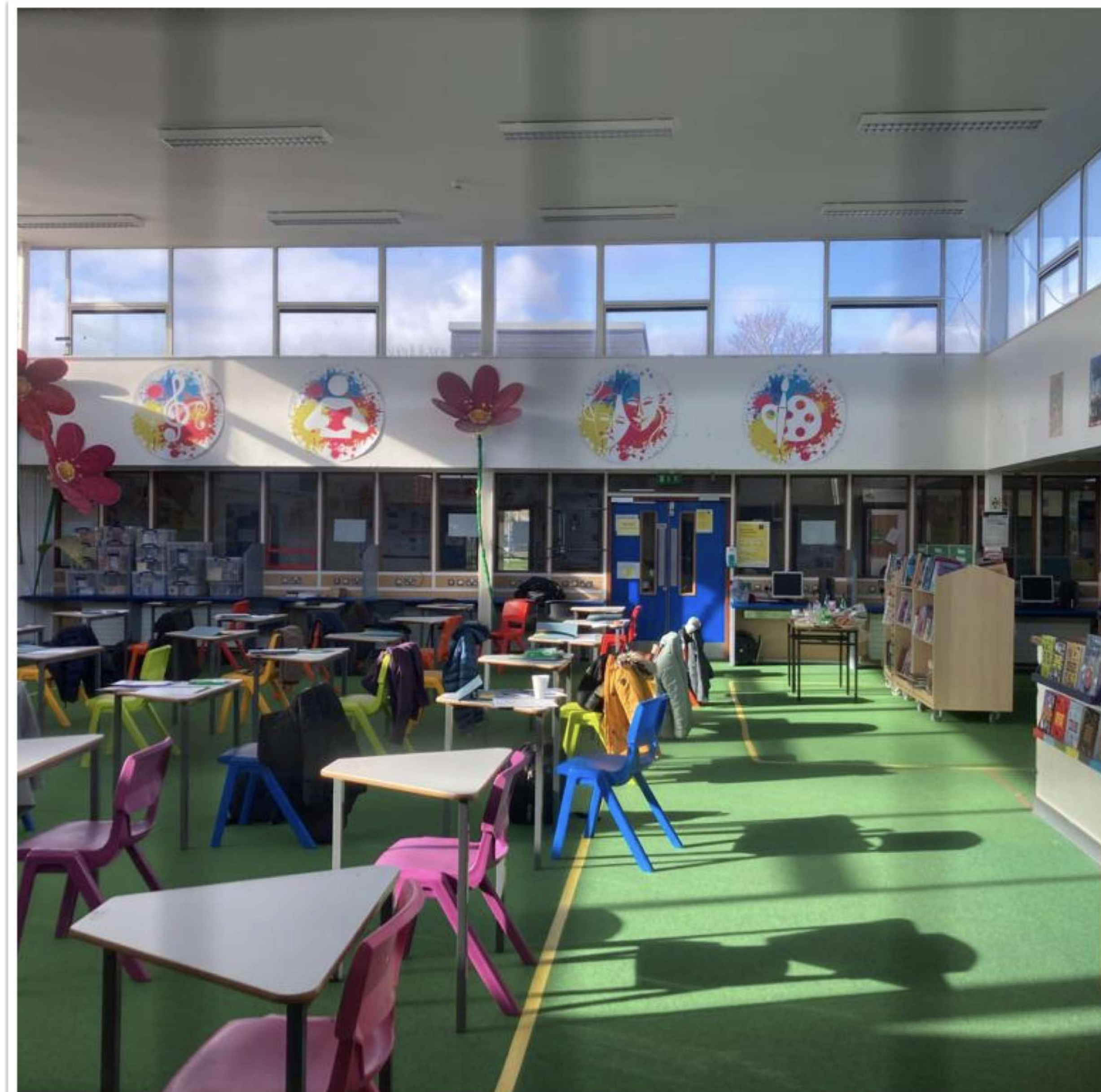

"Hard" CLIL

Content-driven CLIL

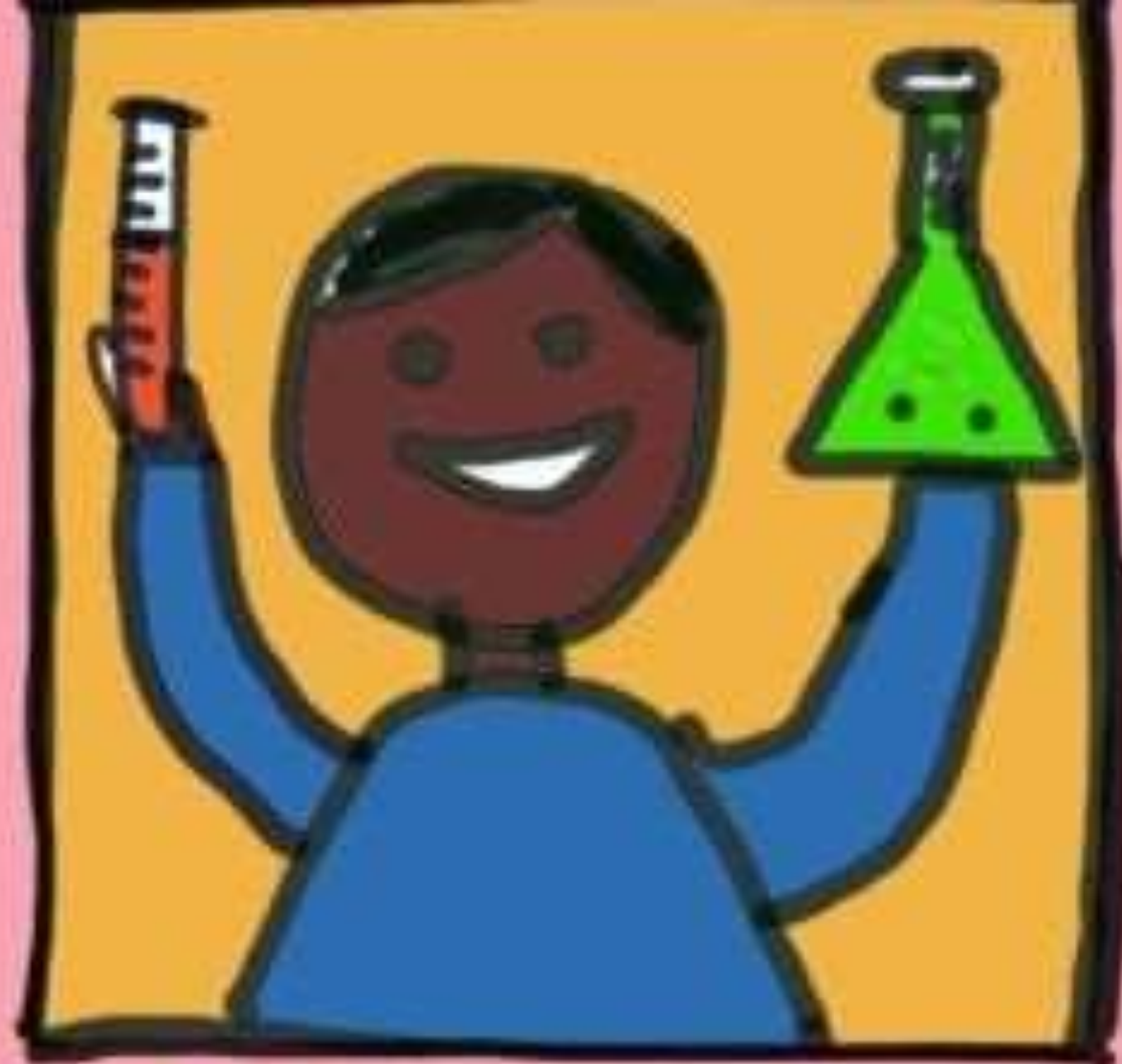
- Content is given primary focus
- Applies to both content and administration of learning
- Learning Objective:
 - **Subject Concepts and Skills**

"Soft" CLIL

Language-driven CLIL

- Using more content than is typical in an EFL class or
- Using didactic units which make greater use of subject-based content

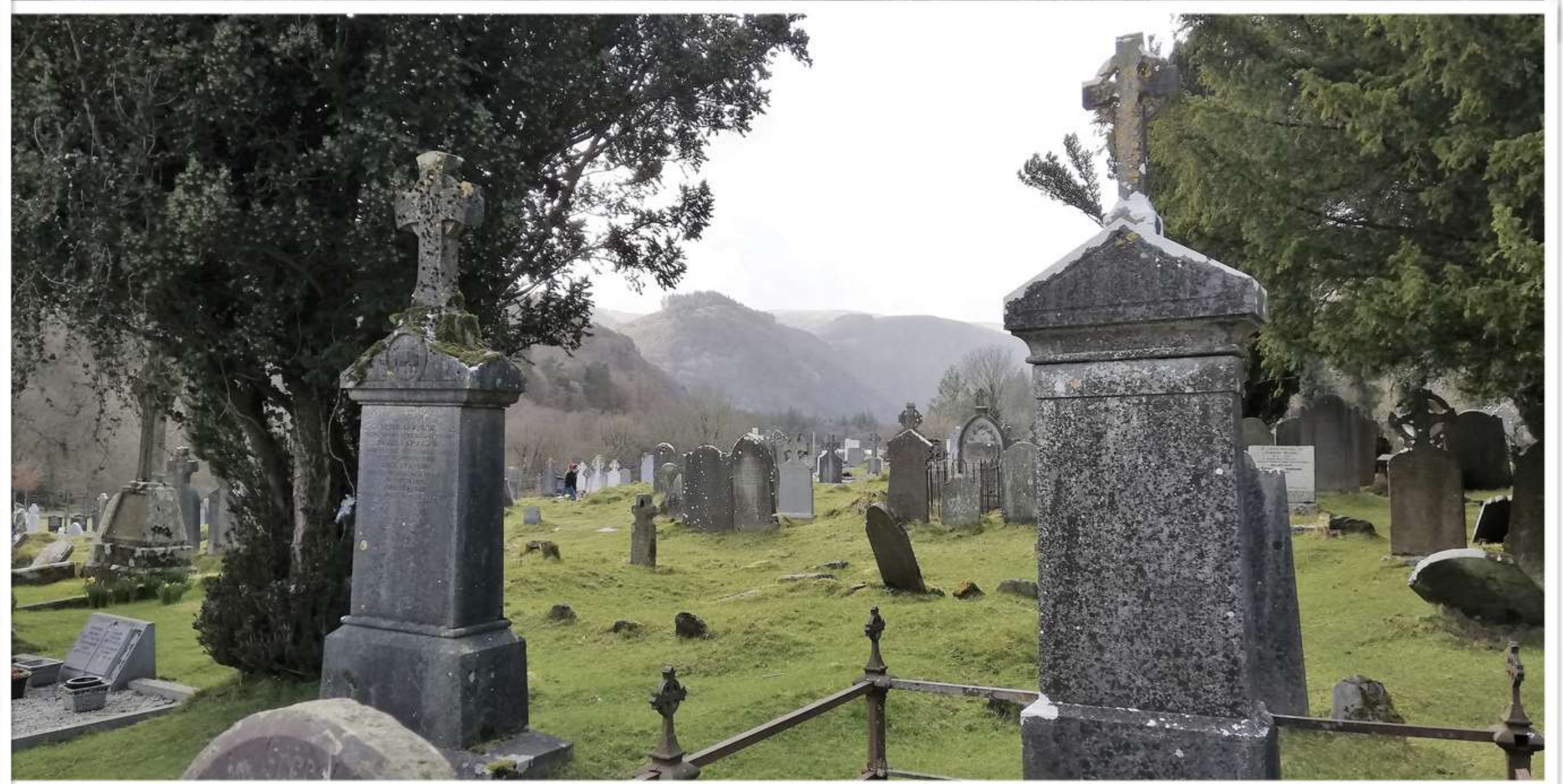
